 every student equally. Additionally, there are concerns about his communication style,

with allegations that he speaks generally rather than providing specific content-related information.

Areas for Improvement:

- Pace of Teaching: Several students have suggested that Dr. Harshvardhan should slow down while teaching. This feedback indicates a need for improved clarity and understanding of the subject matter.

- Use of Teaching Tools: Students recommend the use of various teaching tools and techniques, including PowerPoint presentations, to make the learning process more engaging.


