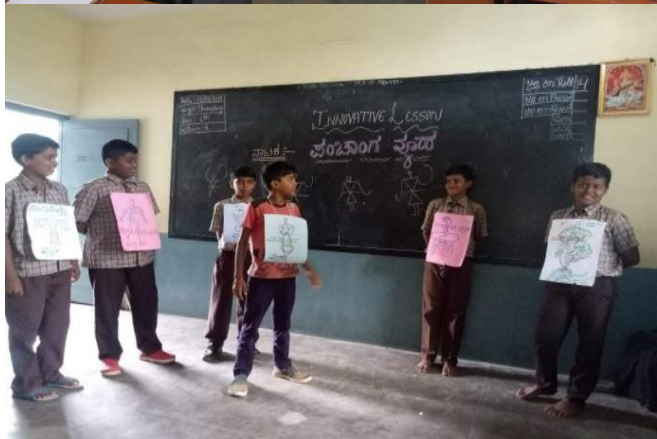


24th June to 04th September 2019
