WHEREAS, the institution Shankaragowda College of Education, S.No.215/1, 216, Khata-D3-1034, Street-K.V., Shankaragowda Road, Ward No.08, Mandya-571401 was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.KAR/B.Ed./59/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/948 dated 11.07.2000 for conducting B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 87 students from the academic session 2000-2001. The intake of the institution was increased from 87 to 100 for Secondary course vide order no.: KR/SEC/SRO/NCTE/2001-2002/9331 dated 17.01.2002.

AND WHEREAS, no affidavit has been submitted by the institution as per record available in the file and therefore no revised order was issued to the institution. There is no further action in the file as per records available. The SRC in its 376th meeting held on 11th - 12th June, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice. The matter was placed before the SRC in its 377th meeting held on 3rd - 04th July, 2019, the Committee was considered and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice was issue to the institution. As per the decision, a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution vide dated 15.07.2019

AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 391st meeting held on 03rd November, 2020 considered and decided to issue last reminder letter to the institution. Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution vide letter dated 06.11.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the matter was considered by the SRC in its 392nd Meeting held on 15th-16th December as under: -

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Shankaragowda College of Education, S.No.215/1, 216, Khata-D3-1034, Street-K.V., Shankaragowda Road, Ward No.08, Mandya-571401 for B.Ed programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students."

NOW THEREFORE, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e., Shankaragowda College of Education, S.No.215/1, 216, Khata-D3-1034, Street-K.V., Shankaragowda Road, Ward No.08, Mandya-571401 for B.Ed. course run by People's Education Society, Mandya for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students (one basic unit) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- V. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
- f. Available infrastructural facilities.
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter.
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
