

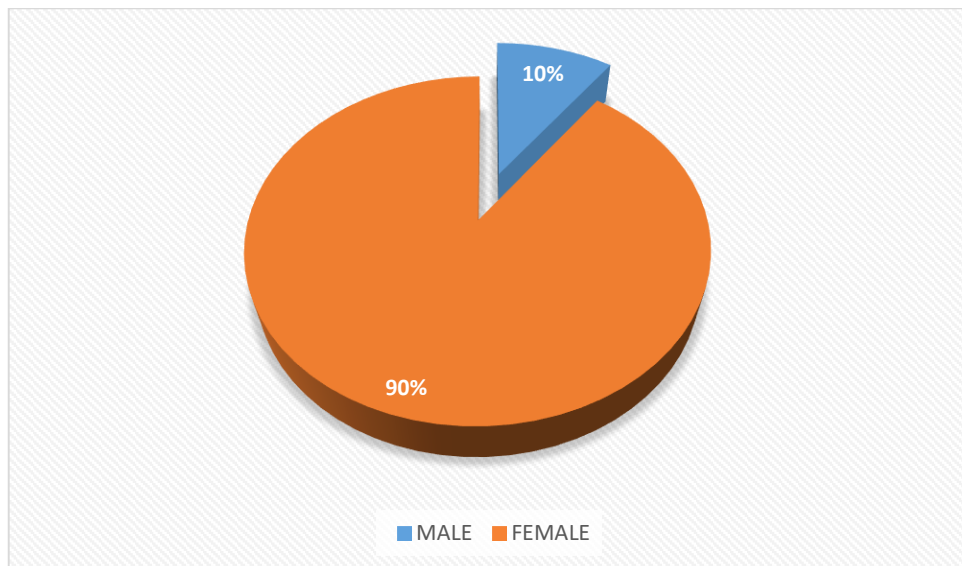

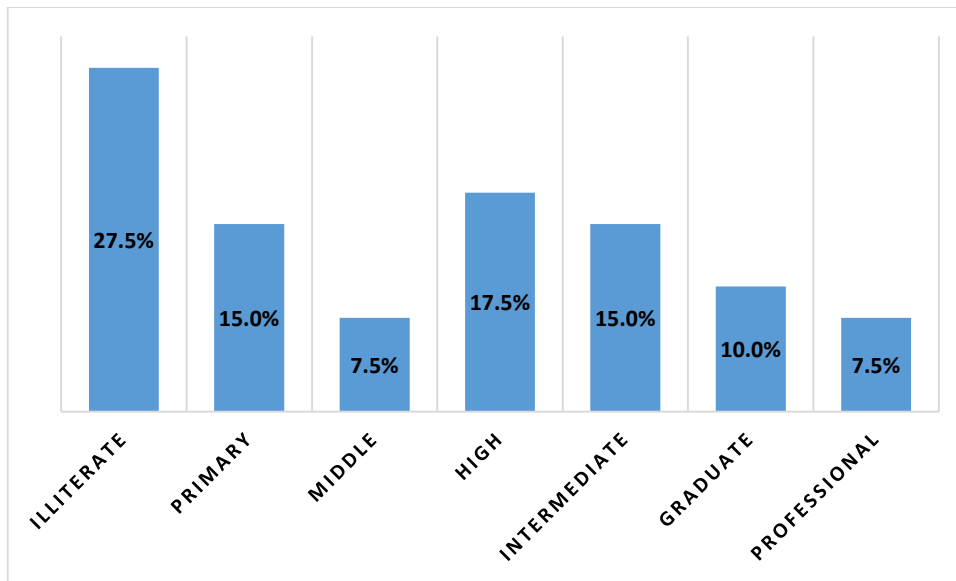


From the above table and graph it shows that out of 40 students, 10% i.e. 4 of them were male students and rest 90% i.e. 36 were female students.

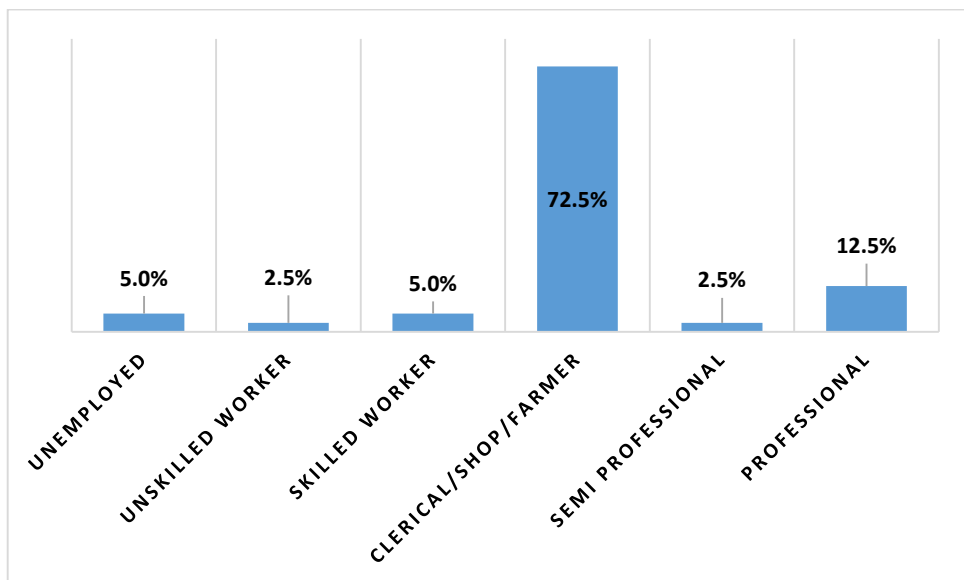

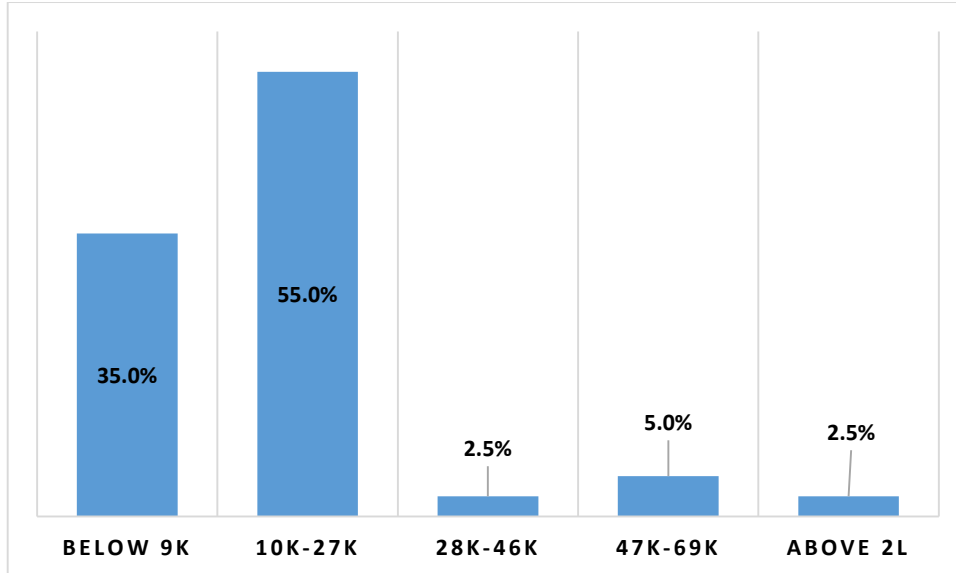
