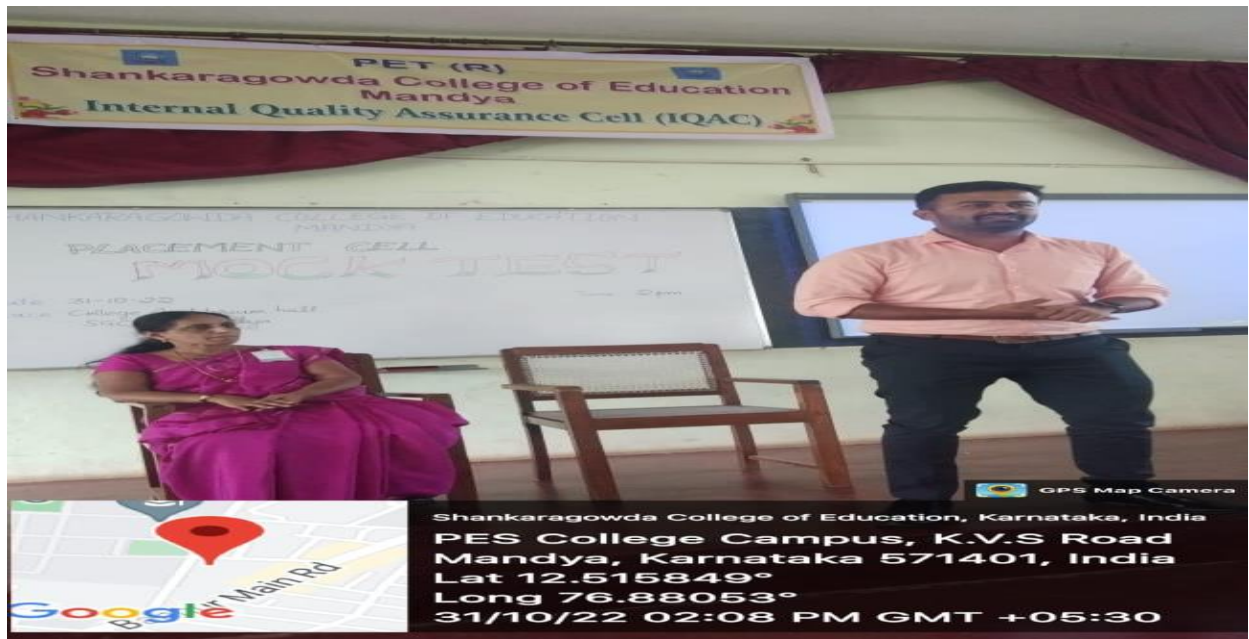
VISIT TO KRISHIK SARVODAYA TRUST 25th MARCH, 2022

WALK-IN INTERVIEW-9th November, 2022

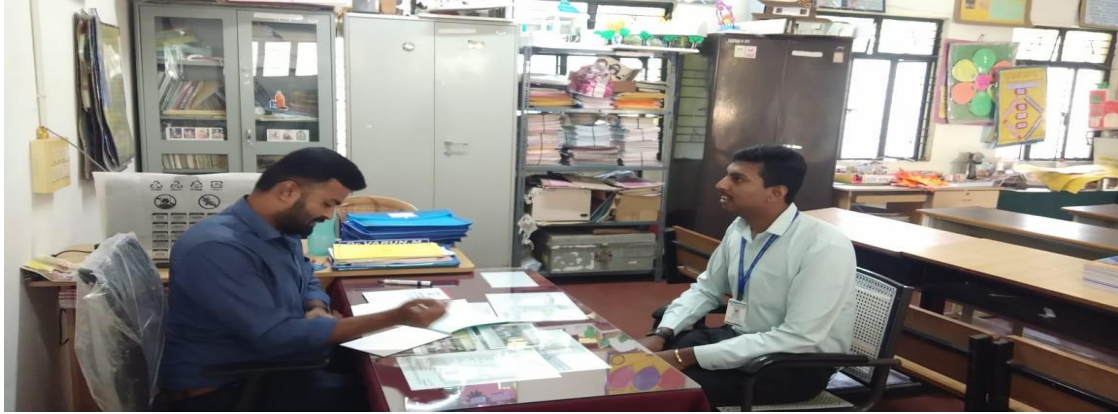
On 9th of November, 2022 four reputed institutions of Mandya City came to our institution for placement drive. The list of the institutions as follows,

TEACHING ATTITUDE TEST (26/10/2023)


Shankaragowda College of Education, Mandya, in association with IQAC and Placement cell conducted Teaching Aptitude Test on 26-10-2023 for both the first year and second year B.Ed prospective teachers. The Teaching aptitude test prepared and standardised by Umme Kulsum was used to collect data.

The aptitude test questionnaire contains 55 statements pertaining to teaching profession. These statements cover the academic, administrative, co-curricular, socio psychological and economic aspects of teaching profession. It also covers general skills related to leadership, empathy and adaptability.

The objectives of administering Teaching Attitude test:

1. To identify the level of aptitude of teacher trainees towards teaching profession.
2. To recognise learner's efficiency in specified areas of teaching.
3. To find the entry behaviour of student teachers.

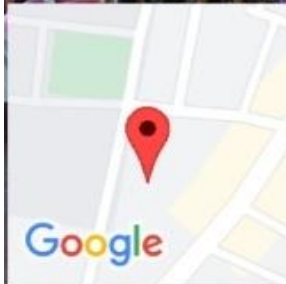

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CAMPUS INTERVIEW-(27/10/2023 & 30/10/2023)

On 27/10/2023 Placement cell organised campus interview for second year B.Ed. prospective teachers in association with IQAC at **Shankaragowda College of Education, Mandya**. 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In the afternoon session, a team of experts from Aryabhata International School conducted campus interview at 3 levels. The team engaged prospective teachers in writing aptitude test, group discussion and finally asked the students to give demonstration lesson to check the presentation and communication skills of our student teachers.

Round 1-Aptitude test It had 3 sets of questionnaires, 1st set of questionnaire was focussed on efficiency in English language and two papers were focussed on methodology.



Round 2-Group Discussion round. For this round the trainees were divided into two groups. Two topics were given to the groups. The topics given for group discussion were “**Mental Health Awareness at workplace**” and “**Two Elephants are fighting on the grass**”. 10 minutes time was given. Later discussion was held in separate rooms.



Round 3- Demonstration round, In this round prospective teachers were informed to give demonstration on specific topics from their respective methodology subject. All the student teachers participated enthusiastically in all the sessions.

After the interview and discussion session was held, Dr Suvarna V. D Principle of our college expressed her views regarding the campus interview and Dr Varun M, coordinator of placement cell delivered vote of thanks. The programme was successful with the coordination of all panel members, staff and all the trainees.
